**2017-2018 DRESS CODE & SHOE REQUIREMENTS**  
**(All Shoes Sold Exclusively at Flair)**

**Twirl Classic (Twirl Pink, Twirl Lilac, Twirl Yellow, Twirl Aqua)**

- Any color or style leotard, tights, skirt, tutus, dresses, jazz shorts, etc.
- Black Revolution tap shoes and Pink Revolution ballet shoes
- Dance bag to keep shoes in & hair pulled back for class

**Twirl to the MAX**

- Any color or style leotard, tights, skirt, tutus, dresses, jazz shorts, etc.
- Black Revolution tap shoes, Pink Revolution ballet shoes and Tan pull on Jazz shoe
- Dance bag to keep shoes in & hair pulled back for class

**Fairytale Ballet**

- Any color or style leotard, tights, skirt, tutus, dresses, jazz shorts, etc.
- Pink Revolution ballet shoes
- Dance bag to keep shoes in & hair pulled back for class

**Hip Hop Flip Flop**

- Anything comfortable to move in such as leggings, sweatpants, harem pants, hoodies, baggie shirts, etc.
- Any sneakers...stylish and fun! (Please note: specific sneakers may be required for the recital depending on the costume)
- *Flip Flop portion of class:*
  - Lycra Jazz shorts or leggings and a tight fitted top, cami, leotard or tank. No baggy t-shirts or pants. (Wear this under Hip Hop attire)
  - Barefoot
  - Dance bag to keep shoes in

**Jazz (including Snazzy Jazzy)**

- Lycra Jazz shorts or leggings and a tight fitted top, cami, leotard or tank. No baggy t-shirts or pants
- Tan pull on Jazz shoe
- Tan tights (optional for class-most likely required for recital)
- Hair pulled back for class

**Saturday K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Ballet/Tap**

- Any color or style leotard, tights, skirt, tutus, dresses, jazz shorts, etc.
- Tan Revolution buckle tap shoe and Pink Revolution ballet shoes
- Dance bag to keep shoes in & hair pulled back for class

**Saturday K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> Jazz/Hip Hop**

- Lycra Jazz shorts or leggings and a tight fitted top, cami, leotard or tank. No baggy t-shirts or pants
- Tan pull on Jazz shoe
- Tan tights (optional for class-most likely required for recital)
- Hair pulled back for class
- *For Hip Hop Portion:* Bring Hip Hop gear to wear over jazz clothes and a pair of sneakers. Hip hop gear such as such as loose fitting tank or shirt, leggings, sweatpants, harem pants, hoodies, basketball shorts, tube socks, etc.

### Petite Pizzazz

- Any color or style leotard, tights, skirt, tutus, dresses, jazz shorts, etc.
- Black Revolution tap shoes & Pink Revolution ballet shoes
- Tan pull on Jazz shoes
- Dance bag to keep shoes in & hair pulled back for class

### Tap Classes:

- Any color/style dance wear
- 1st-5th Grade: Tan Revolution buckle tap shoe
  - Saturday Kind, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> gd. Ballet/Tap will wear the Tan Revolution buckle tap shoe
- 6th-12th Grade: Black Signature tap shoe

### Ballet (1st Grade and Up):

- Solid black leotard and pink tights. No tutus or skirts.
- Pink Revolution split-sole ballet shoes
- ***Hair MUST be pulled back in a secure bun with hairnet -ALL AGES and LEVELS.***
- No jewelry (small studs are fine)

### Hip-Hop (including boys):

- Anything comfortable to move in such as leggings, sweatpants, harem pants, hoodies, basketball shorts, tube socks, etc.
- Any sneakers...stylish and fun! (please note: specific sneakers may be required for the recital depending on the costume)
- Hair may be down, but pulled away from face

### Lyrical/Contemporary:

- Lycra Jazz shorts or leggings and a tight fitted top, cami, leotard or tank. No baggy t-shirts or pants
- Barefoot
- Hair pulled back for class

### Spotlight:

#### *Spotlight Jazz*

- Lycra Jazz shorts or leggings and a tight fitted top, cami, leotard or tank. No baggy t-shirts or pants
  - ***Please Note*** – Petite Spotlight dancers will be wearing Jazz shorts OVER their ballet attire & will not need a jazz top on a regular basis. Please see email from Beth Mason.
- Tan pull on Jazz shoes
- Tan tights (optional for class-may be required for recital)
- Hair pulled back for class
  - ***Please Note*** – Please note, Spotlight ballet and jazz classes tend to be back-to-back. Many times we will request that you wear a bun to jazz to save time with the class transition. Please see your spotlight Jazz teacher for specifics.

#### *Spotlight Ballet*

- Solid black leotard and pink tights. No tutus or skirts.
- Pink Revolution split-sole ballet shoes
- ***Hair MUST be pulled back in a secure bun with hairnet -ALL AGES and LEVELS.***
- No jewelry (small studs are fine)
